



*These gloves were worn by John Graham of Claverhouse, Viscount Dundee, the charismatic Jacobite leader who was mortally wounded leading his men to victory at the Battle of Killiecrankie on 27 July 1689.*



Killiecrankie1689 is in favour of upgrading the A9 road but is against the current proposal.



Transport Scotland plans to dump up to 150,000m<sup>3</sup> of filler material on the most sensitive part of the battlefield.



This proposal makes no attempt to avoid destroying key features on the core battlefield.



The area where the fighting was concentrated will be obliterated.



A Public Local Inquiry would provide a way to formulate a better plan.



There is no legislation to protect the site. Only public pressure will save the battlefield.
